

Review of presentation requirements

Review of requirements

- 15 minute presentations
- 2–3 minutes of Q&A afterwards
- Every team member is expected to give part of the presentation
- **Must turn in a list of references for material presented, on the day of your presentation**
- Graded on 5 criteria, each on a scale of 1-5

List of references

- Only list material actually presented
- Chances are good if you're working from peer-reviewed research, your sources also have a list of references; use that as a template.
- General form:
 - Author 1, Author 2, ... (Year). Title. Source title, Volume, Issue, Pages.

Grading criteria

Group

- Is the research topic relevant to the field of cognitive psychology?
- Was scientific data presented in support of the claims made?
- Was enough detail & methodology presented to assess the validity of the scientific data?

Individual

- Was the topic presented in an organized & professional manner?
- Did the team member appear to make a significant contribution to the overall project?
