Your Paper

- Should address:
 - what were the author's hypotheses?
 - i.e. subjects performing a task will do *this* or *that*, depending on some aspect of cognition
 - what were their predictions?
 - if they do *this*, then data will look like *this*, if they do *that*, then data will look like...

Your Paper

- Should address:
 - what was the basic methodology
 - what does the data tell us about the predictions?
 - what did the findings tell the researchers about cognition in general?

Your Paper

- submission
 - should include your own write-up AND the PDF of the paper you chose to use in your project - so attach both files when submitting on LMS
 - Due next Friday, April 24th

Your Presentation

- the night before your presentation
 - email us your powerpoint slides
 - all slides for the group should be in one file
 - name the file with the last names of group members

Your Presentation

- Each of you will have 5 minutes to talk about your paper
- This is a short time, so practice, practice, practice saying everything you want to say in that time
- You can use slides to support your presentation
 - but with only 5 minutes, you can only really use 2 or 3 slides max

Your Presentation

- clarity and conciseness is key
- In your presentation try to address how your particular paper fits in with your group's chosen topic and draw connections between group members' findings
